Under our current bylaws, Student Members are only eligible to stand for and vote on the Student Representative position. They are neither eligible to stand for the other positions, nor to nominate potential candidates. Each position entails a three-year commitment (in the case of the President-Elect, one year will be served as President-Elect, one year as President, and one year as Past-President) from May 2018 to the end of April 2021. In cases where more than one candidate is nominated for a particular position, an election will be held according to the bylaws of the association.

CACBT-ACTCC has a mandate to seek a Board of Directors whose membership reflects the multidisciplinary, linguistic and geographical diversity of Cognitive and Behavioural Therapists in Canada. We particularly encourage francophone and/or non-psychologist nominees as well as nominees from coast to coast.
