

SUBMISSIONS FOR POSTERS/SYMPOSIA CACBT/ACTCC 2019 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can I submit more than one symposium, oral presentation or poster?

Yes, there is no specified limit to the number of posters or symposia that you can submit for consideration to the CACBT/ACTCC Conference.

Do presenters have to be registered for the Conference?

Yes, if you are the individual presenting a poster, or are a speaker on a symposium, you must be registered for the Conference.

Can I register for just one day of the Conference?

No. Registration is for the full two days of the conference only.

Can submissions be in French?

Yes! CACBT/ACTCC is pleased to host conference content in both of Canada's official languages. We welcome submissions in either French or English. However, because both English and French posters will be presented at the same Conference poster session, presenters can decide to have bilingual posters, or to provide abstracts in both French and English if desired.

When will authors get a notice of acceptance for poster and symposium submissions?

The date of acceptances has yet to be determined. We encourage you to visit the CACBT/ACTCC website regularly for updates on the Conference, including Conference events and important deadline dates.

Will all authors receive a notification of acceptance?

No, only the first author of poster and symposium submissions will receive notification of acceptance. Notification dates will also be posted on the website.

When will the poster session be held?

All details about conference information and events will be posted on the website as they become available.

What are the requirements for poster sizes?

Precise measurements for poster sizes will be sent with the notification of acceptance, as well as listed on the website.
