CALL FOR HALF-DAY CONFERENCE WORKSHOPS

CACBT-ACTCC is now accepting proposals for half-day workshops (3 hours) for our upcoming meeting in Halifax, Nova Scotia. In-conference workshops are typically given by a senior expert in the topic area. All topics are welcome, but preference will be given to those that are consistent with the conference theme or that attendees have expressed an interest in from previous conference surveys (e.g., Dissemination, Cognitive-behavioural treatment of Posttraumatic Stress Disorder, Cognitive-behavioural treatment of eating disorders, Acceptance and Commitment Therapy, Clinical supervision). We are particularly interested in workshops that take a lifespan approach or touch on issues of diversity; however, workshop topics outside of these areas are also welcome.

Workshop proposals are due by 5:00 pm, Eastern Standard Time, on Monday, November 4, 2019. Information about the conference can be found at www.cacbt.ca.

CACBT-ACTCC is proud to offer conference content presented entirely in either of Canada's official languages. We welcome submissions for workshops in either English or French.

The submission should be sent in a single document file, preferably in MS Word format, to Dr. David Dozois at dzois@uwo.ca. Files should be named after the last name of the corresponding author (e.g., Smith.doc). A confirmation e-mail will be provided, normally within 48 hours.

Submission Guidelines

1. Include an abstract, no longer than 500 words.
2. The abstract should include a brief overview of the workshop, didactic approaches that will be used in the workshop, and list three to five learning objectives.
3. The abstract should contain a title in block capital letters at the top of the page, followed by the names of the authors and their affiliations, followed by a blank line, followed by the abstract.
4. On a separate page, list each author followed by their full mailing address and their email address.
5. An abbreviated CV (2 pages, maximum).

Submissions will be reviewed for scientific and clinical merit by the CACBT Conference Submission Review Committee. Applicants will be notified of their acceptance by December 20, 2019.
